NOTICE OF INTENDED MARRIAGE

Note: The marriage laws in Australia are some of the most liberating marriage laws in the world.

They don't require you to apply for a license to marry, nor do they require permission or acceptance from the community. They just require two people to consent to joining a union, voluntarily for life. They also require people to be of a sound mind, and part of that is giving one month's notice to a celebrant. The marriage laws in Australia don't require you to be of a certain faith, or to adhere to a certain moral standard. They aren't a vessel for childbirth, or sexual intercourse. The marriage laws aren't about weddings, white dresses, and pleasing mum and dad. They're about formalising, recognising, and celebrating a union between two people. So until there is legal paperwork to register this kind of marriage, the people on the other side of this form are formally giving notice of their intention to enter into this kind of marriage where gender isn't a deciding factor into whether or not you can be married.
